



## **Return to Play/Meeting Attendance Protocols for LCA Community Association**

The Lakeview Community Association provides leadership to enhance the quality of life in its neighborhoods.

Its objective is to encourage a sense of community and to work to improve the quality of life for the people in the neighborhood by promoting and assisting in the development of the recreational, social and educational well-being of the residents

We will be following all Saskatchewan Government guidelines as outlined on: [saskatchewan.ca/coronavirus](http://saskatchewan.ca/coronavirus) . Physical distancing, and use of hand sanitizer will be used for both indoor and outdoor programs or in person meetings. Non-surgical face masks will be required in situations where physical distancing is not possible and encouraged in any other in person classes or meetings. Class sizes will be limited to maintain the required physical distances and maximum group gatherings will be kept at no more than 30 whether gathering is indoors or outside. Facility will ensure cleaning of high touch points. For activities at other sites, the leaders of the activity is responsible for disinfecting high touch surfaces at the start and end of any activity (i.e. AGM).

### **Client/colleague/member interaction**

- Our board meetings will be taken in person (socially distanced).
- Our AGM will be held in person with the ability to 'Zoom' in for members

### **Registration for programs**

- No cash/cheques will be accepted
- We will be offering virtual classes for the time being:
  - Parent/Kid Virtual Baking Classes
  - Kids Virtual Dance
  - Home Alone Course
  - Babysitting Course
- We will look into in person classes in 2021

## **Rink**

- Our intent is to have the outdoor rink this winter. However, we are working on getting confirmation that we still have water access to flood the rink. When we do operate the rink, it will follow the Saskatchewan Government guidelines as outlined at [saskatchewan.ca/coronavirus](https://saskatchewan.ca/coronavirus) and will not exceed the maximum number of people allowed to gather (this includes volunteers/coaches/instructors/supervisors/spectators). Physical distancing will also be required where applicable.

## **Physical distancing during meetings**

- 2m distancing between people will be maintained through chairs/tables
- All participants attending in person meetings must provide contact information should contact tracing be required. Hand sanitizing will occur during this sign in process. All high touch surfaces will be disinfected at the start and end of the meeting. Paper sharing will be eliminated by introducing flip chart use by chair when possible. When sharing is needed (pens for sign up, etc.) a process will be in place to ensure these items are disinfected between uses.
- Spacing of chairs or markers (pylons, etc.) will be used in order to help ensure physical distancing will be maintained between participants. Reminders of this as well as using other measures such as wearing a mask, proper sneezing/coughing protocol, etc. will be reminded periodically throughout the meeting.

## **Shared devices and equipment**

- Only one person will be in charge of storage/setting up the video conference equipment and will wipe down before and after every meeting
