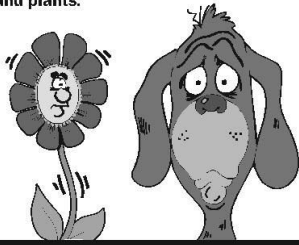

## Reasons to Scoop the Poop!

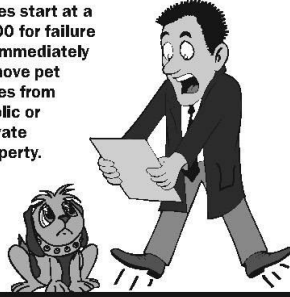
### Poop is not fertilizer.

Dog feces do not fertilize the ground and has negative effects on grass and plants.



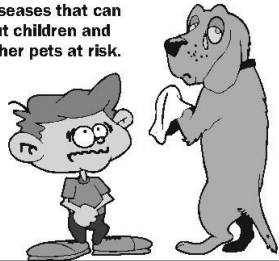
### Poop is expensive.

**Report it:** Report the graffiti.

**Phone:** Call the property maintenance hotline at 306-975-2828

**Police:** Report at [www.police.saskatoon.sk.ca](http://www.police.saskatoon.sk.ca). Graffiti is a crime and can be reported to police.

**If you remove graffiti within 24 hours, there is a 90% chance it will not reappear. If you wait longer than two weeks to remove graffiti, there is a 90% chance that it will reappear.**

### Home Alone Course

Friday, September 18 from 6 pm to 8:30 pm

Taught virtually through Zoom

Cost: \$40

A 2.5-hour class designed to provide children aged 10-14 years with the necessary skills and knowledge to be safe and responsible when home alone for short periods of time.

### Babysitting Course

Saturday, October 3 from 9 am to 3:30 pm

Taught virtually through Zoom

Cost: \$50

This course is aimed at 11-16 year olds interested in taking responsibility for younger children. Content in the 6.5 hour class includes safety practices, child care basics, introductory first aid and activities to try. Hands on participation and skill development are the focus.

The courses require a minimum of 10 participants to go ahead, and will have a maximum of 18 participants.
