# Moose on the Move

Sightings of moose in the Lakeview community have been increasing as moose populations in the region expand. Moose encounters in the city are most common in the spring and fall when animals are more mobile but can occur on any month. These large animals can weigh 200-500 kg and are a serious risk for collisions with vehicles, knocking over yard fences, and may potentially harm people when they are distressed in these urban areas. If you see a moose in the city, call 911 immediately and report it. Never approach it and move far away to a safe area such as a house or vehicle. Sometimes moose leave the city on their own, but wildlife officers may come and dart the animal to put it to sleep temporarily so they can release it far away from the city.

Animals that can be seen in Saskatoon include coyotes, skunks, foxes, moose, deer, rabbits, porcupines, beavers, muskrats and many others. The City of Saskatoon offers some limited services related to wildlife. If you have concerns about wildlife in Saskatoon please call Urban Biological Services at 306-975-3300. If there is an emergency after hours, please call the 24 hour customer service center at 306-975-2476. For concerns about larger animals (e.g. moose, deer, bears) contact the Saskatchewan Ministry of Environment at 306-933-6240.
