Message from Ward 9 Councillor Tiffany Paulsen

I hope everyone is loving this warm winter we have been having!!!

Although we have not had much snow, I still have received a few inquiries about snow removal. In particular, people have been calling about removing snow in front of schools – which is something I am following up on.

We have been talking about snow removal at City Council recently as citizens have been asking for more details on snow **removal** as opposed to just moving the snow to one side of the street by city plows. The civic administration reported that just to plough residential streets (but leave the clumps of snow along the sides of the streets) would cost at least a quarter of a million dollars per snowfall.

Moreover, it would cost three million dollars per snowfall to pick the snow off the streets and take it to the snow dumps.

In case you didn't know, there are over 1900 kilometres of residential streets in this city. That's like pushing snow from Saskatoon to Chicago.

Council will be looking at both of these options during the next budget cycle.

Another issue City Council has been discussing is pets! Have you ever complained about the cost of your dog or cat licences? Well, help is on the way in the form of a unique marketing proposal from the Star Phoenix. They will be working with local businesses to offer discounts for various products that you will qualify for when you buy your pet license. Stay tuned for more news on this as the program is developed. I welcome this program since I have always had concerns about forcing people who keep their cats indoors to buy licenses. At least this way there will be additional motivation to obey the cat licensing by-law.

Finally, as most of you know, there is a civic election on October 24, 2012. There has been a re-drawing of ward boundaries given some of the population shifts. However, just for everyone's information, Ward 9 will be staying exactly the same. Ward 9 includes Lakeview, Lakeridge, Lakewood Suburban Centre, Rosewood and Wildwood. Just an early reminder on how important it is to vote!
